Wolves BUG have organised three Saturday leisure rides  
during the Wolverhampton Cycle Challenge. All rides meet at  
10am for 10.30am start.

**Bike Ride 1 - Saturday 12 September 2009 – Beginners' 8 mile loop.**

**Start location:** Pendeford Square by Pendeford Library, to the left of  
Morrison's Supermarket frontage, off Bladon Road, Pendeford, WV9 5NJ.

**Description:** This is a beginners' ride, starting in Pendeford Square and  
involving an 8 mile loop to reach the South Staffs countryside. Riders will  
enjoy a swooping descent to Lower Hatton farm on the return leg.  
Whippeeee!!! The ride will use as many paved bridleways and motor traffic-  
free paths as possible.

**Bike Ride 2 - Saturday 19 September 2009**

**Bantock Park to Wombourne or Halfpenny Green, 16 miles +**

**Start location:** Bantock Park by the playground.

**Description:** This ride starts at Bantock Park and will lead out into South  
Staffs to either the café in Wombourne by the cricket green or the  
Halfpenny Green Vineyard restaurant. (Participants can choose.) The  
return ride will be via either Kingswinford railway walk or the Staffordshire  
and Worcestershire canal.

**Bike Ride 3 - Saturday 26 September 2009**

**West Park Loop via The Fox at Shipley, 25 miles**

**Start location:** West Park by the tea pavilion.

**Description:** Starting in West Park, the ride will follow the National Cycle  
Network Route 81 to get to Bilbrook, Codsall and County Lane, where the  
ride will then turn for Pattingham. The lunch stop will be at The Fox at  
Shipley. The return ride will be via Ebtree.

All welcome on roadworthy cycles. Under-16s to be accompanied by a  
parent or guardian. Please bring your own spare inner tubes / puncture
